Now Nortera, the company has strong partnerships with over 200 local farmers, ensuring that fresh vegetables are picked and packed within hours, maintaining the highest quality standards. Those vegetables are then sold under some of the world's most recognized brands, including Del Monte.

"Nortera's growth in Strathroy is a testament to the strength of our County"s agricultural sector and the strategic location that connects us to major markets in Canada and the United States," said Brian Ropp, Middlesex County Warden. "Located at the crossroads of key transportation routes, including immediate access to major highways, this expansion not only benefits Nortera but also strengthens our region's position as a key player in the agri-food industry."

Nortera's executive team reiterated the importance of the company's prime location and expressed sincere gratitude to the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc for their exceptional support throughout the expansion process. Their timely assistance was integral in ensuring that this project could move forward smoothly and efficiently.
