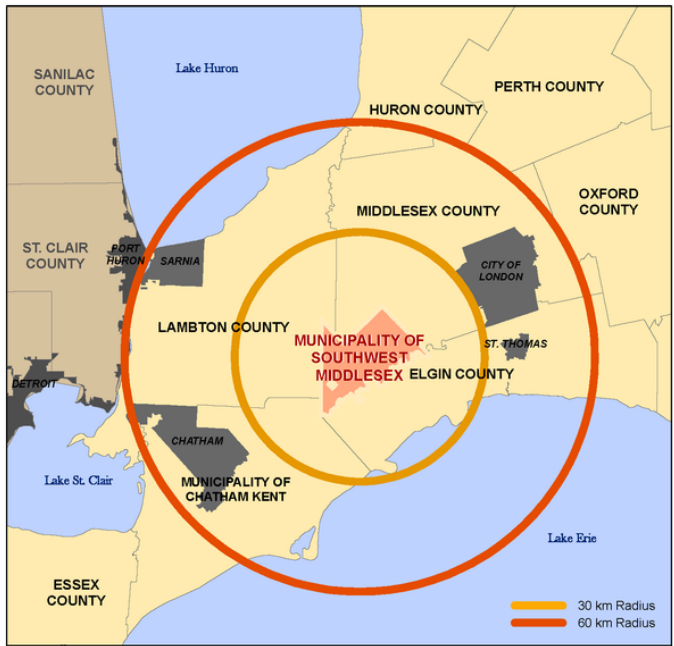

# Close Proximity to Markets



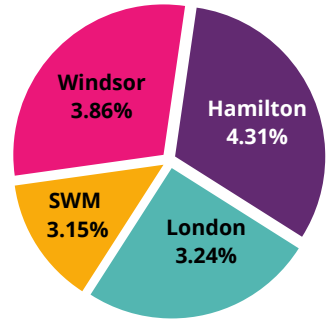
- Reach up to 120 million customers within a single day's shipping time
- Easy travel on well maintained roads
- Located within 30 km of both 401 (15 min) & 402 (20 min)
- Located within an hour drive of US border crossing
- CP rail is located at the North edge of Glencoe (3.9 km) with a ViaRail stop (1.4 km) in the heart of Glencoe
- 61 km to London International Airport (London)
- 142 km to Windsor International Airport (Windsor)
- 221 km to Pearson International Airport (Toronto)
- 82 km from Sarnia Harbour, the closest water port



# Tax Rates & Competitive Wages

Southwest Middlesex has an advantageous tax rate for new industrial development with the 2022 tax rate set at 0.03151912. An estimate of potential property taxes can be calculated by multiplying the current tax rate by the estimated value of the property once complete.

Southwest Middlesex has experienced a lower wage rate as compared to the rest of Ontario and Canada overall. This is offset by traditionally lower housing costs.

## Labourforce & Lifestyle

Southwest Middlesex is a great place to live and work. Slightly lower average wage rate than in larger urban centres, is offset by greater housing affordability. We are addressing housing imbalances through planning policies and through our recently approved CIP.

Health Care Services through two hospitals operated under Middlesex Health Alliance (Four Counties Health Services - Newbury and Strathroy Middlesex General Hospital - Strathroy) with 24-hour emergency services are available within minutes. Both hospitals offer a full range of inpatient and ambulatory care.

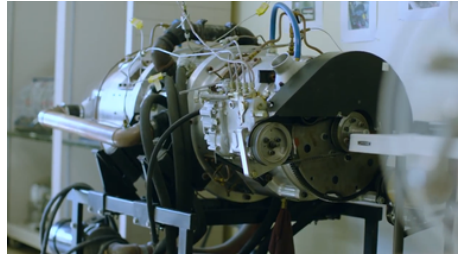

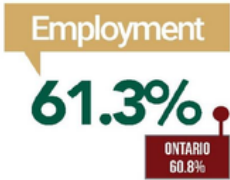
